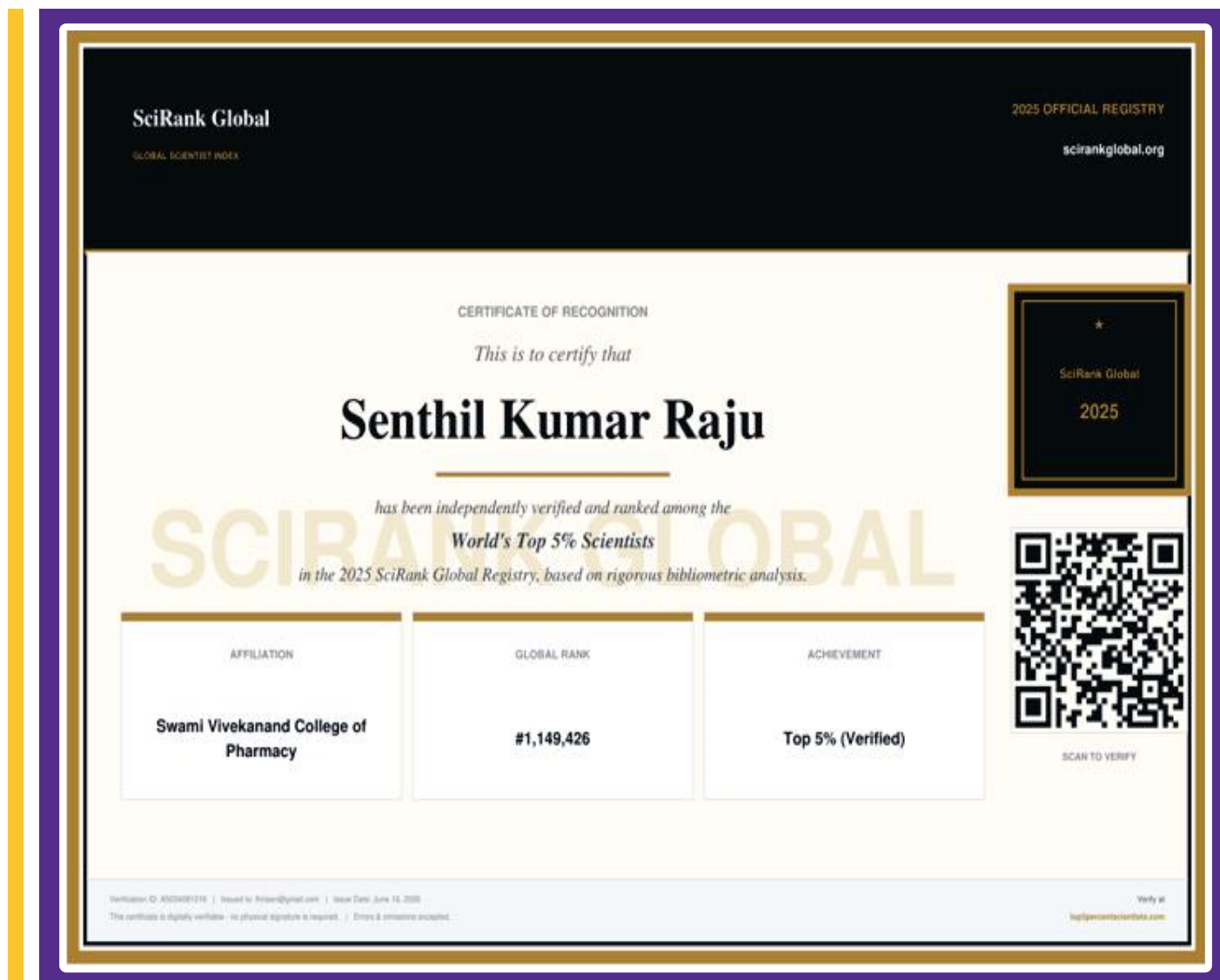

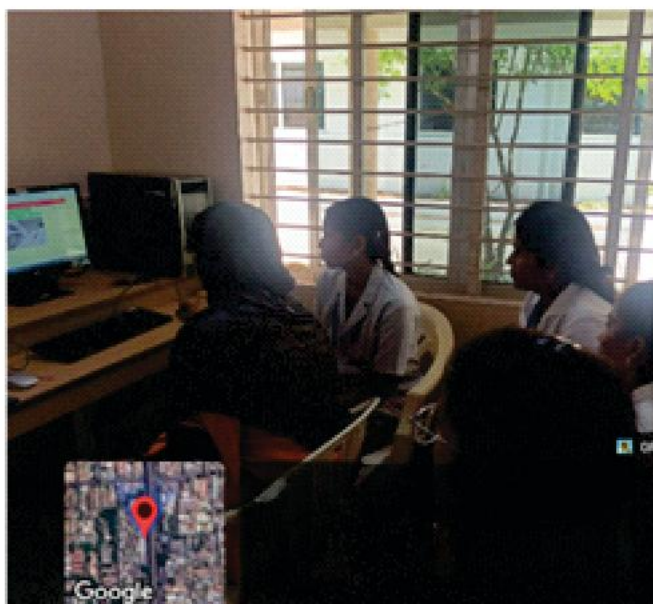

TARGETED NUTRITION IN MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS: A COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW OF EVIDENCE-BASED DIETARY INTERVENTIONS

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ABSTRACT

Inflammation, demyelination, and axonal damage within the central nervous system are hallmarks of multiple sclerosis (MS), a chronic, immune-mediated neurodegenerative disease. Growing interest has been focused on the function of diet in regulating disease activity and symptom development, even though the etiology of multiple sclerosis is still complex and involves genetic, environmental, and immunological factors. According to new research, dietary factors may have an impact on oxidative stress, gut microbiota composition, inflammatory pathways, and general brain health—all of which are pertinent to the pathophysiology of multiple sclerosis. The present state of knowledge on nutritional interventions in the treatment of multiple sclerosis is examined in this study, along with the possible advantages and disadvantages of different dietary strategies, such as the Mediterranean diet, ketogenic diet, low-fat diet and intermittent fasting. In relation to immune modulation and neuroprotection, the functions of particular nutrients—such as vitamin D, omega-3 fatty acids, antioxidants, and polyphenols—are examined. Furthermore, the significance of gut health and the newly discovered gut-brain axis in multiple sclerosis are examined, emphasizing the potential impact of dietary decisions on microbial balance and systemic inflammation.

INTRODUCTION

In multiple sclerosis (MS), a chronic, central nervous system (CNS) neuroinflammatory disease, immune mediated oligodendrocyte demyelination ultimately leads to axonal injury, and can occur focally within white matter or as diffuse lesions within grey matter [1]. It is complex, and its etiology may be influenced by a number of metabolic or environmental variables [2]. Eating habits and lifestyle choices can either worsen or improve MS symptoms by modifying inflammation, interacting with human cells, and influencing the commensal gut microbiota. Nutrition is now acknowledged as one of the potential risk factors for the development of MS and may have uses in its management and treatment [3]. Malnutrition is a common condition in MS patients, as evidenced by clinical signs of weight loss, overweight, or obesity, as well as vitamin deficiencies [4]. Malnutrition in MS patients has been linked to immune system dysfunction, which impairs cognitive function and causes a chronic inflammatory state that causes relapses more frequently and accelerates the disease's development [5]. Furthermore, dietary status has a negative impact on how well medication therapy works [6]. Certain models seem very restricted and challenging to apply over time, which could result in nutrient shortages. Even though the different diets differ, they all share key characteristics, like avoiding processed meals, foods high in glycaemic index, and foods high in saturated fat; cutting back on fatty red meat; and consuming more fruits and vegetables [7].

TYPES OF MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS

Relapsing-remitting MS:

This is the most prevalent type. RRMS is the original diagnosis for about 85% of MS patients. In RRMS, there are times of remission, when symptoms partially or completely disappear, after episodes of new or worsening symptoms [8].

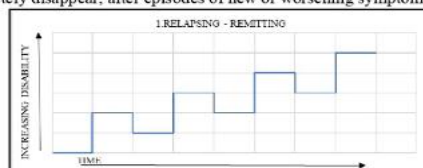


Fig. 58.1 Relapsing-Remitting MS

Primary progressive MS:

Primary progressive multiple sclerosis progressively worsens over time. There are either few or no remissions and no distinct episodes of symptoms. Additionally, MS medications are less effective for this type of MS. Ten percent or so of MS patients have this kind of MS.

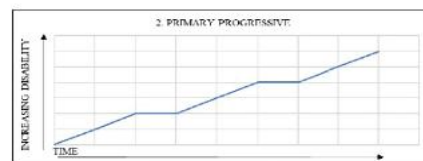


Fig. 58.2 Primary progressive MS
